


Year 2 Summer 1 Curriculum Overview

Jigsaw (PSHE)



We will be learning about relationships. This will be with friends and families.

Maths – Fractions and Number



We will be working hard on fluency. We will be adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers up to 100. We will then be solving word problems.

Also this term we will look at Fractions of shapes and numbers.

Music

Listening and know how music is used descriptively for a particular purpose.

DT

Textiles – using a template, simple joining with a choice of stitches.

English

We will be reading The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark. Once explored we will be writing our own narrative based on the story.

We will then be looking at letter writing.

The children will practise writing letters, words and sentences linked to the traditional tales. We will be focussing on writing sentences.

They will continue to work on their phonics daily. They will practice their handwriting daily.

Living Things

Science Living Things

In this unit we will:

- Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive
- Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other.
- Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats
- Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food.

Geography

Look at the UK. What countries are within it and what are the capital cities.
Look at human and physical features.
Explore maps.

Homework

Create a habitat for a unicorn. This could be a small model or a drawing. Please include a description of why it would be a good habitat.
