The British Passport	Recognise features of the passport make their own passport, take their own photograph. Compare with another from elsewhere in the world.	Recognise features of the passport. What tells us it's British?
Our People	Recognise facial features and colours. African, Chinese, White European. Briefly mention others – Eskimo, Sami from around Europe.	Difference/similarity/all people of the world. Living together peacefully. Areas/Regions. Lancashire – Birmingham etc.
Our Government	Name the parties, senior politicians. Where they meet, how they are selected. House of Commons / Lords.	To know the Prime Minister – 10 Downing Street. To begin to understand the election process.
