Stonehenge is built. Guy Fawkes is arrested. Start of Fire of London. Colossus Mark II gets to work. Julius Caesar invades Britain. Isambard Kingdom Brunel inspects SS Great Britain. Great British Writers (not necessarily children's writers)	Shakespeare, Bronte Sisters, J.K. Rowling Etc etc etc	Children particularly familiar with the work and life of one writer. Teacher's choice.
British Beliefs	Christian – R.C. Church of England, Methodist, Baptist etc – Vicar, Priest, Pastor. Judaism – Jews, Rabbi, Synagogue Islamic – Mosque, Imman, Temple	Simple understanding relating to one God.
