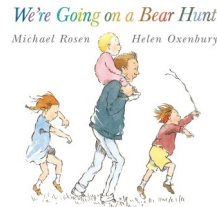


# Year 1 Autumn Second Half Term Curriculum Overview

## Jigsaw (PSHE)

Celebrating Difference

The children will learn and talk about how they are the same and different to their friends. We will find out what bullying means and what to do about it.



## English

Following on from last half term the children will be writing non chronological reports about owls and penguins.

They will write poems about Fireworks and Autumn.

We will also be reading 'The Bear Hunt'. The children will write a series of sentences linked to the story.

## History

The children will learn about 'The Gunpowder Plot' and about 'Remembrance Day'.



# Fire, Fire!



**RE** The children will learn the Christian 'Christmas story'.



**PE** Year 1 will receive sports coaching from an Everton Partnership coach on a Wednesday afternoon.

## Maths— Addition and Subtraction / Shape

The children will work on adding and subtracting numbers within 10. Including finding missing numbers, the difference between two numbers and number bonds within and to 10. The children will also be taught to recognise and describe basic 2D and 3D shapes.



## Science / Geography—Autumn

The children will look for signs of Autumn and look closely at Autumn leaves. We will record the types of weather we have throughout November.



## Art

The children will be using pastels and chalks to create firework pictures.

## Design Technology

The children will work on moving pictures. They will create pictures with sliders, levers and pop ups etc.

The children will also create cards and decorations for Christmas



**Computing** The children will continue to explore 'Purple Mash' and begin to use a keyboard to type.

**Curriculum Homework:** To make a painting, picture or model to represent Autumn. It is to be completed by the end of term. Pupils who complete the homework will receive treasure from the treasure box.
