

Year 1 Summer First Half Term Curriculum Overview

Jigsaw (PSHE)

Relationships

The children will learn about different types of family, what makes a good friend and who they can go to for help and support.

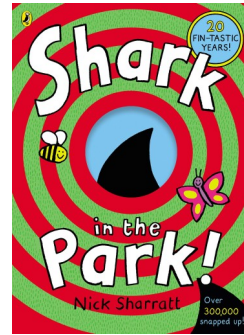


English

The children will be reading and writing instructions.

They will also be reading the story 'Shark in the Park' by Nick Sharratt. (A story based in a familiar setting). The children will also be writing their own short stories based on this book.

They will continue to work on their phonics and handwriting daily.



Maths

This term the children will be introduced to simple multiplication, division and fractions. They will be practising counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. They will also continue to work on place value and addition and subtraction.

Science

The children will name and sort different types of materials. They will investigate their properties and why they are used for certain purposes.

Geography

The children will investigate their school grounds and local area.

The children will investigate, design and make playground structures. They will practise using tools to enable them to cut, stick and join.

RE The children will learn about Jewish 'Shabbat'.



PE Year 1 will receive judo lessons from a judo coach on a Monday afternoon.

Computing The children will continue to explore 'Purple Mash' and practise using the keyboard to type.
