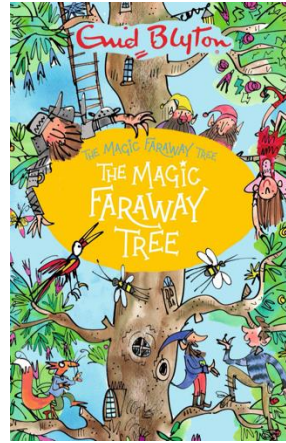

Homework

Your homework for this half term is to grow a plant. It may grow into a flower or a fruit or vegetable.

Your challenge is to look after your plant and keep a diary of how it grows.

Plants

- Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots; stem/trunk; leaves; and flowers.
- Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant.
- Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.
- Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.
