Jigsaw (PSHE)



We will be following the Jigsaw unit 'Being Me in My World'. We will be focusing on settling the children into their new class and following class routines.

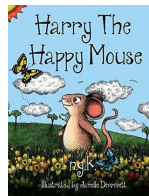
English

We will be reading 'Harry the Happy Mouse' and nursery rhymes based upon mice such as 'Hickory Dickory Dock'.

They will use a variety of sources including information books to find out about different types of animals.

The children will practise writing letters, words and sentences linked to the story, rhymes and animals.

They will continue to work on their **Phonics** daily. They will practice their **handwriting** often.



Science—Animals

The children will learn to identify, sort and classify a variety of common animals.

RE The children will learn the Christian 'Creation Story'.

PE Year 1 will have PE with Mr Woods on a Wednesday afternoon.

Penguins, Giraffes and Mice

Maths —The children will work on representing, comparing and exploring numbers within 10. Finding 1 more or 1 less than a given number. They will also be revisiting the composition of each number to 10 including doubling and halving.



Geography

The children will learn about the hot and cold places of the world.

(The Poles/Equator).



Art

The children will be exploring line and shape using various media.



Computing

The children will learn about 'Online Safety'. They will learn to log on to their chrome books and be introduced to 'Purple Mash'.
