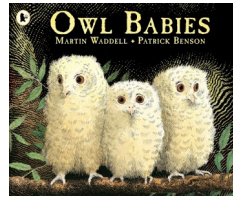


Year 1 Autumn Second Half Term Curriculum Overview

Jigsaw (PSHE)

Celebrating Difference

The children will learn and talk about how they are the same and different to their friends. We will find out what bullying means and what to do about it.



English

The children will start by writing simple poems about Fireworks.

They will move on to writing non chronological reports about owls and penguins.

We will also be reading 'Owl Babies'. The children will write a series of sentences linked to the story.

They will continue to work on their phonics and reading daily. They will practice their handwriting often.



Art The children will complete some Christmas craft.



Fire, Fire!

RE The children will learn the Christian 'Christmas story'.



Music

The children will play the African drums and learn Christmas songs



PE Year 1 will be developing ball skills on a Wednesday afternoon.

Maths— Addition and Subtraction / Shape

This half term the children will focus on addition and subtraction. They will also be taught to recognise and describe basic 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

The children will look for signs of Autumn and learn all about different types of animals.



History

The children will learn about 'The Gunpowder Plot' and about 'Remembrance Day'.



Computing The children will be developing their computing skills with 'Junior Jam' on a Friday afternoon.
