Jigsaw (PSHE)

Healthy Me -The children will learn about keeping healthy including healthy eating, exercise, keeping clean and staying safe.

English

We will be reading the traditional tale 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff'.

The children will write a series of sentences linked to the story.

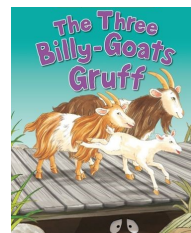
The children will read and write their own version of the traditional rhyme 'Mary Mary Quite Contrary'.

They will continue to work on their phonics daily. They will practice their handwriting often.



Maths— Addition and Subtraction / Place Value

The children will continue to work on adding and subtracting numbers within 20. Including finding missing numbers and number bonds to 20. The children will be taught place value to 50 and practise counting in twos, fives and tens.



Science The children will investigate materials and look for signs of spring.



Geography

The children will be investigating the Seasonal and daily Weather Patterns of the UK.



The Great Outdoors

Art The children will create painting in the style of Clarice Cliff. They will also make Mother Day cards and complete some Easter crafts.



RE The children will be learning the Easter Story".

PE Year 1 will be taught PE on Wednesday. They will work on invasion games.

Computing The children will continue to work on animation.

Music The children will learn to play simple songs on the keyboards.
