Jigsaw (PSHE)

Celebrating Difference

The children will learn and talk about how they are the same and different to their friends. We will find out what bullying means and what to do about it.

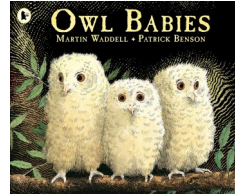
Zones of Regulation The children will continue to explore the zones and the tools they can use to support with their emotional wellbeing.

English

The children will start by writing simple poems about Fireworks.

We will then be reading 'Owl Babies'. The children will write a series of sentences linked to the story.

They will continue to work on their phonics and reading daily. They will practice their handwriting often.

RE The children will learn the Christian 'Christmas story'.

Art This half term the children will be developing their drawing skills. They will also complete some Christmas craft.



History

The children will learn about 'The Gunpowder Plot' and about 'Remembrance Day'.



Music

The children will explore playing the ukulele and learn Christmas songs.

Maths— Addition and Subtraction / Shape

This half term the children will focus on number to 20. They will also be taught to recognise and describe basic 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

The children will learn all about different types of animals.

Computing The children will be developing their computing skills with 'Junior Jam' on a Friday afternoon.
