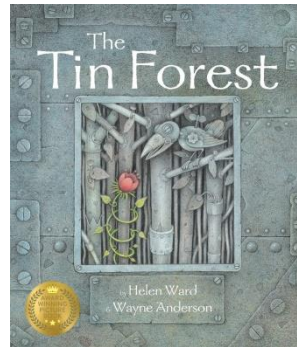


English
